

## **NEW RULES PERTAINING TO EXPOSED FEMALE CATTLE**

### **35:15-38-3.1 Exposed female cattle**

Exposed female cattle shall be officially identified and change ownership only:

- (1) If the female bovine is diagnosed at least four (4) months pregnant by an accredited veterinarian;
- (2) If the female bovine is sold for slaughter only;
- (3) If the female bovine is consigned to an approved feedlot to be fed for slaughter only;
- (4) If the female bovine has a calf less than thirty (30) days old and has not been exposed to a bull since calving, or;
- (5) If six (6) months has passed since the female bovine's exposure to a bull.
