Hereby makes application for a permit to import, transport, and distribute fluid market milk and/or milk products in the State of Oklahoma. Form FDA 2359i, Interstate Milk Shipper's Report, reviewed and signed by Public Health Service, Food and Drug Administration, Regional Milk Specialist (available from official state enforcement agency in your state) for processing plant, receiving stations, and all raw milk supplies.

We understand that the permit cannot be issued prior to receipt of the above-requested information. When Form FDA 2359i is not available within a 24-month interval, this firm agrees to pay the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture all expenses involved in an inspection to determine compliance, including salary, per diem, transportation and administrative costs.

Manufactured Milk and Manufactured Milk Products

Most recent copy of inspection report from state regulatory authority; and to maintain your permit, submit inspection report on an annual basis hereafter.

We understand that the permit cannot be issued prior to receipt of the above-requested information. When copy of appropriate inspection report is not available on an annual basis, this firm agrees to pay the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture all expenses involved in an inspection to determine compliance, including salary, per diem, transportation and administrative costs.

We agree that the permit, if issued, will become null and void and will voluntarily surrender same at any time the milk supply fails to comply with the information herein contained, and that no milk or milk product will be distributed or transported into any city or town in Oklahoma without first obtaining an additional permit, if required by local ordinance, from the local health officer having jurisdiction therein.
