Permission to File Paper Appeal

Purpose: The Permission to File Paper Appeal form must be completed and submitted to MPC in order to request authorization for paper filing of the Petition for Appeal.

Instructions: Sign the Permission to File Paper Appeal form and submit with completed Petition for Appeal.

Pursuant to OAC 455:10-11-17, you have the right to appeal this adverse action to the Merit Protection Commission within twenty (20) calendar days.

Online Filing System

Effective October 31, 2008, the Merit Protection Commission's (MPC) launches its Online Filing System. The Commission requires all users to file petitions, requests, pleadings, and documents through the system. Petitioners and Representatives are required to first register with the system in order to obtain a login id and password. Permission to file paper appeal (Conventional Filing Form)
