Alfalfa trade as well as grass hay trade was mostly slow. Demand mostly moderate. Movement was moderate to fairly active with most deliveries of previously contracted or purchased hay. Prices fully steady. Statewide rains improved pastures and crops in western Oklahoma but curtailed hay and livestock movement in most central and eastern counties. Green-up is well underway in southern and south central Oklahoma.

Eastern Oklahoma: No recent sales confirmed.
