Central Oklahoma: Prices steady to 10.00 lower. Supreme quality large square bales .85 to 1.00 per point RFV, mostly .85 to .90 at 165.00-200.00, mostly 170.00-185.00. Premium quality large square bales 140.00-170.00. Good quality dry cow or bunk hay 120.00-140.00. Fair to Good alfalfa round bales 90.00-100.00. Horse quality small square bales 12.00-14.00 per bale in 70-80 pound bales. Grinding hay 50.00-55.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Premium square bales 150.00-170.00. Good quality large square bales 120.00-140.00. Round bales Good quality 100.00-130.00. Small square bales horse quality alfalfa 320.00-350.00 per ton.
