

Poultry Waste Management

Education Requirements

Registered poultry operators and certified poultry waste applicators are required to attend:

- **9 hours of initial education within the first year of becoming registered or licensed and**
- **2 hours of continuing education each year until receiving a total of 19 training hours.**

Upon receiving the 19 required hours, the operator or applicator will attain graduate status but shall be required to receive:

- **2 hours of continuing education every 3 years thereafter.**

If you became a graduate during **2013** you must attend a minimum of **one** continuing education class during the 3-year block:

Jan. 1, 2014 — Dec. 31, 2016
