



Oklahoma Biological Product Renewals

Each biological product distributed, sold, offered for sale or used in Oklahoma or delivered for transportation or transported in intrastate or interstate commerce shall be registered with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry on an annual basis. Every biological product label must be registered.

All biological product registrations shall be issued for a period of one (1) year. The registration shall be renewed annually and shall expire on March 20 of each year. Biological product registrations may be renewed for the ensuing year, without penalty, if a properly completed application is filed with the Department no later than the fifteenth day of the month first following the date of expiration. If the application is not received by that date, a penalty of twice the amount of the renewal fee shall be charged for renewal of the biological product registration.

We strongly encourage you to renew your biological product registrations online by using Kelly Registration Systems platform. Registrants are provided a username and password for access to links that allow you to register new products, update labels, and renew existing products. Processing fees do apply; however the efficiency of renewing online allows for timelier issuance of approved biological product permits.

Options for renewal are:

1. Complete and pay online utilizing the Kelly Registration System (payment provided via check, ACH Debit or Credit Card. Additional fee applies to Credit Card payments)
2. Manually complete hard-copy form and mail with payment (payment provided via check or credit card.)

Please note the following information:

For discontinued biologics with stock still in the marketplace, registrants may:

- a. Maintain registration until the supply is exhausted
 - b. Have all of the distributors/dealers remove and dispose of unregistered products
 - c. Recall products not registered
- Option b or c – If product is found for sale in Oklahoma, a penalty will be assessed.
