

Change of ownership

On all country sales (any sale other than through an approved market) buyer and seller are equally and individually responsible for meeting the testing requirements prior to changes in ownership.

Dairy Cattle

TB Testing Requirements

Between 2 and 6 months of age – Individual official identification

Sexually intact animals that are 6 months of age/older or 450 pounds/more –

Individual official identification required on all

Negative TB test within 60 days prior to change in ownership **OR**

Originate from a herd with a biennial complete herd negative caudal fold test of all cattle 20 months/older **OR**

Originate from accredited TB Free Herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Complete Herd Test)

Steers and spayed heifers – Individual official identification required. No TB test requirements for Change of Ownership within Oklahoma

Beef Cattle and Bison

TB Testing Requirements

No TB test requirements for Beef Cattle/Bison on Change of Ownership within Oklahoma

Horses

Negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia within 12 months prior to change of ownership

(Foals less than 6 months of age accompanied by their negative tested dam are exempt from test requirements)

Sheep and Goats

Individual ID compliant with USDA Scrapie program

(or registration tattoo if accompanied by registration certificate)

Cervidae

Negative Brucellosis test within 30 days prior to change of ownership **OR**

Originate from a Brucellosis Free Herd (Herd Certification Number and Date of last Complete Herd Test)
